### **Transfer Requirements**

- Complete the associate degree with a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA.
- 2. ENG 111, ENG 112, and a college-level math course must be completed with a C or higher in the first 45 credits. See the pathway to select the correct math course(s) for the intended major
- Transfer to Mason for the fall or spring semester immediately following the conferral of the pathway associate degree.
- Grades of C or higher are required for transfer credit. Select programs may require a higher grade in specified courses. See the program-specific requirements noted on the pathway.
- Students must complete their associate degree within five years of entering the program.
